## 02 | Foreword

### Setting the Stage for Cohort 2

The Klugekopf TechBridge Programme was founded on a simple but powerful conviction: that the underrepresentation of women in Africa's technology sector is not a reflection of capacity, but of access. Every data point on the gender gap in STEM every statistic about women holding fewer than 25% of tech roles across African countries represents not a ceiling but an open door waiting to be unlocked.

Cohort 2 of the Klugekopf TechBridge Programme was designed with that door firmly in mind. Building on the foundational achievements of our pilot cohort, we entered this phase with a sharper curriculum, stronger systems, and a more expansive vision. Where Cohort 1 proved the concept, Cohort 2 has proved the scale.

The programme's design reflects the realities of our participants' lives women who are students, entrepreneurs, young professionals, and career changers, all navigating the demands of daily life while investing in their futures. Our workshop format, WhatsApp community channels, live facilitated sessions, and self-paced digital resources were built to meet participants where they are.

This report documents our journey through Cohort 2: the programmes delivered, the partnerships formed, the community built, and the impact generated. It is a record of what becomes possible when vision meets execution, and when a community chooses to rise together.

We invite you to read it as both a retrospective and a call to action because the work of leading Africa's digital future does not pause between cohorts.

## 03 | Year in Review

### 2026: A Year of Transformation

The 2025 programme year marked a significant leap forward for Klugekopf TechBridge from a pilot programme validating our model to a fully operational training platform delivering multiple tracks simultaneously, supported by a growing volunteer corps and an expanding partner network.

*Cohort 2 received 100 applications from across Africa. Following a competitive selection process, 20 exceptional women were chosen a 20% acceptance rate reflecting both the high demand for the programme and our commitment to a focused, high-quality learning experience.*

### Programme Tracks Delivered

Klugekopf TechBridge 2.0 expanded significantly from the original four-track model to deliver seven specialised programmes, ensuring that participants could find a pathway aligned with their career goals and prior experience:

#### AI Agent Building

Hands-on training in building and deploying AI agents using modern tools and frameworks, with a practical capstone project.

#### Digital Marketing

Comprehensive digital strategy, social media marketing, content creation, SEO, email automation, and analytics.

#### Web3 Social Media Management

Emerging skills at the intersection of Web3 technology and community management for decentralised platforms.

### Looking Forward: The Road Ahead

Cohort 2 of the Klugekopf TechBridge Programme has demonstrated, beyond any doubt, that the model works. When women are given access to structured training, an engaged community, meaningful mentorship, and real employment pathways, they transform and they transform everything around them.

The data from this cohort will inform the design of Cohort 3. The partnerships forged will deepen. The LMS platforms built will scale. The volunteer network will grow. And the pipeline of African women entering the digital economy will widen with every participant who completes a track and steps into her next chapter.

Our focus for the next programme year includes the expansion of LMS capabilities across all seven tracks, the deepening of our recruitment partnership network to include additional Web3, AI, and fintech employers, the launch of a structured alumni mentorship programme pairing graduates with incoming cohort participants, and the development of new course tracks responsive to market demand and participant interest.

We also remain committed to our geographic expansion vision using Nigeria as the proven model before extending our concentrated impact methodology to additional African countries. Every cohort brings that vision closer.

To our participants: you are the reason this programme exists. Your growth is our greatest achievement. To our partners: your trust and investment make the impossible routine. To our supporters and donors: your belief in African women in tech is changing the continent.

The digital future of Africa is female. And we are building it, together.
